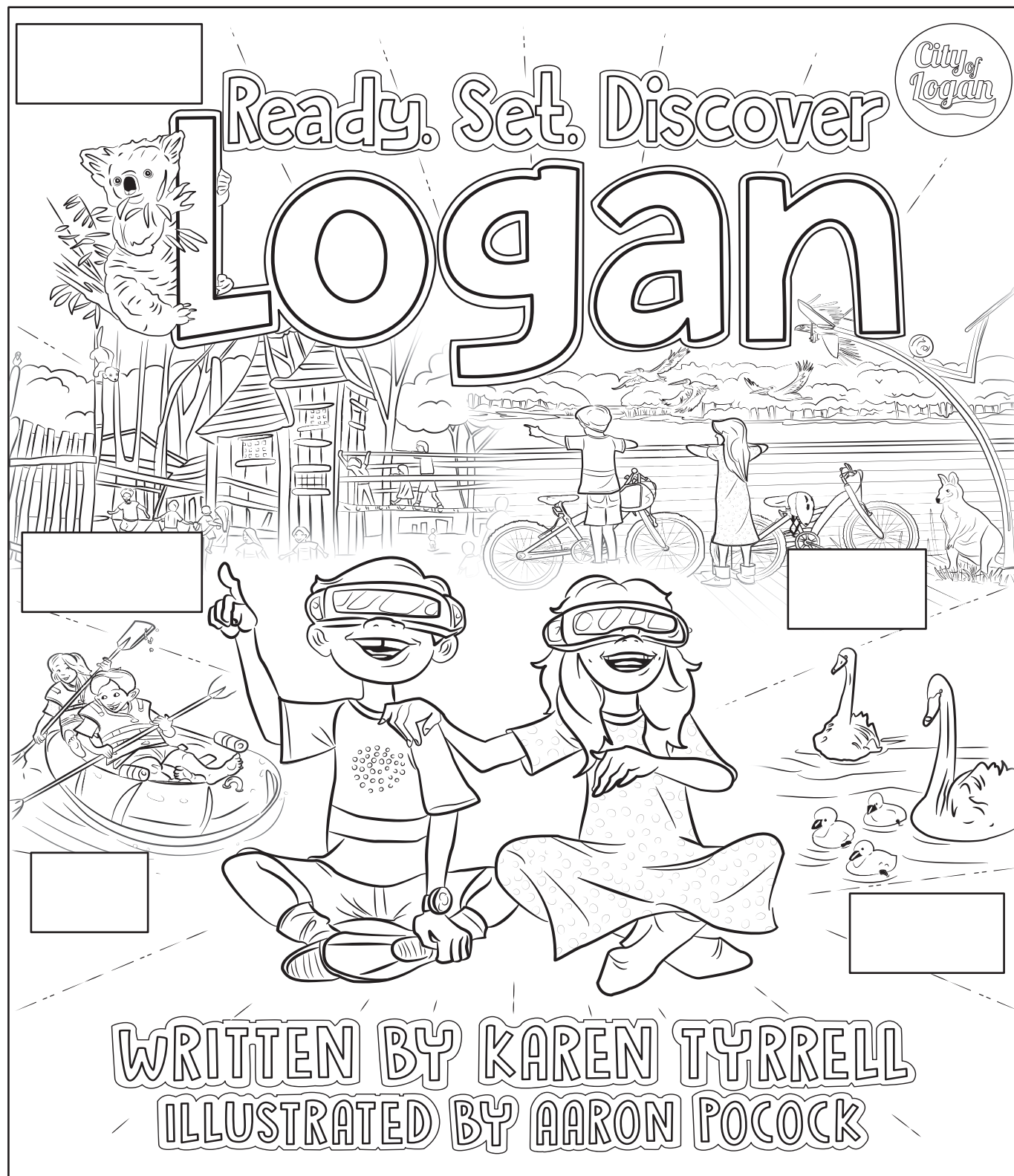

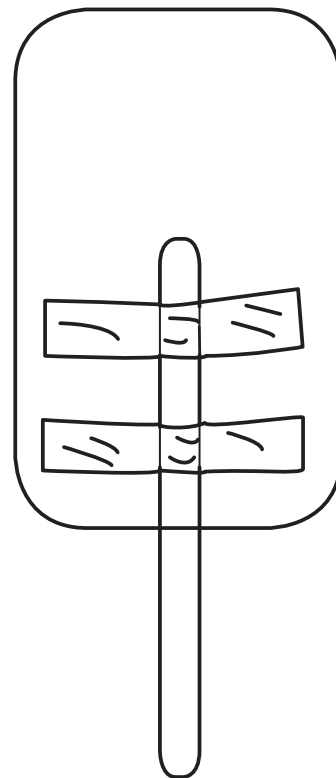

At the Daisy Hill Koala Centre, Yana gazed at cuddly koalas and Bunji heard bees buzzing.

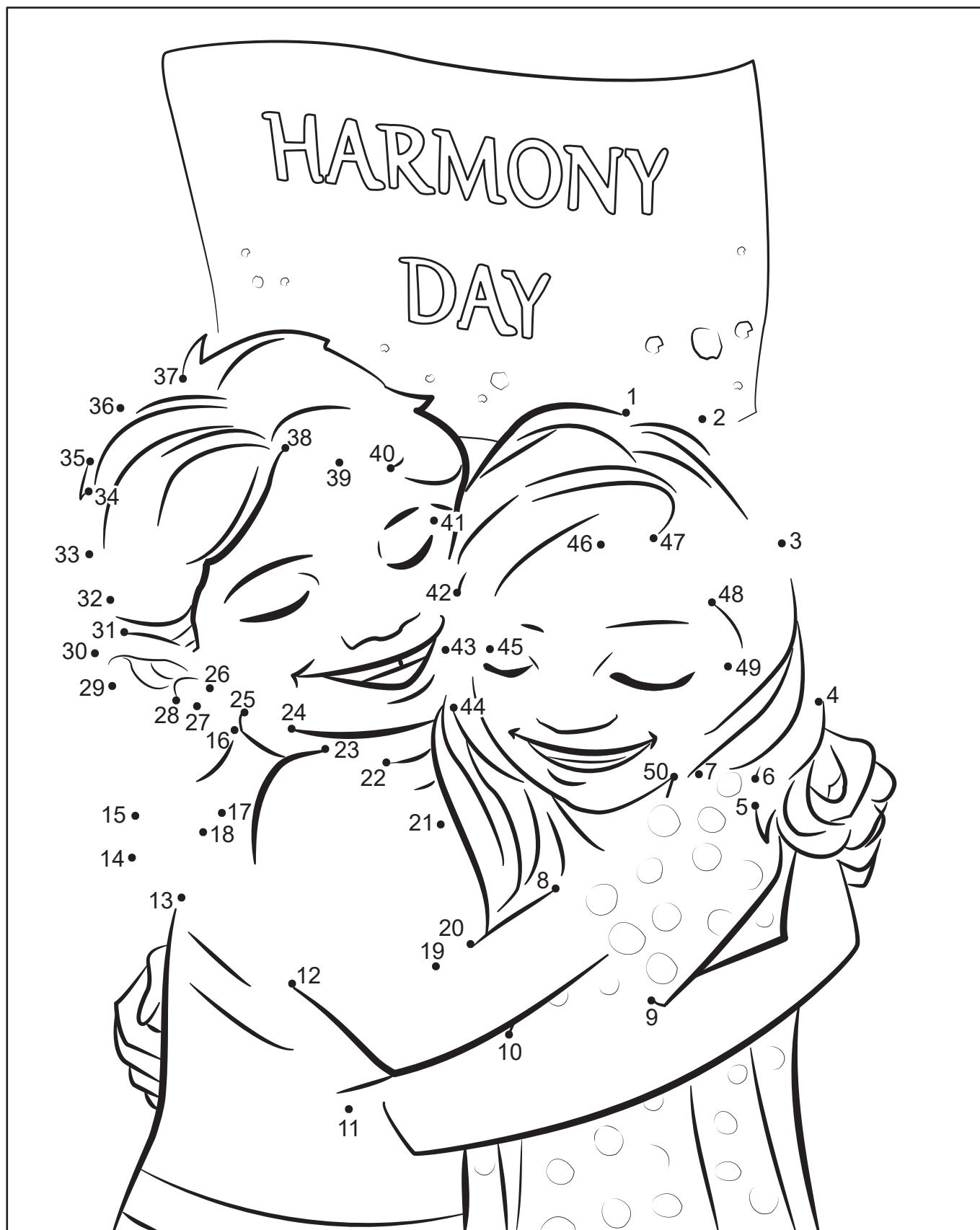
Yana and Bunji lit a glowing candle and rang the blessing bell at Chung Tian Temple.

Dot to Dot - 1 to 50 Yana and Bunji enjoyed Harmony Day with their families.

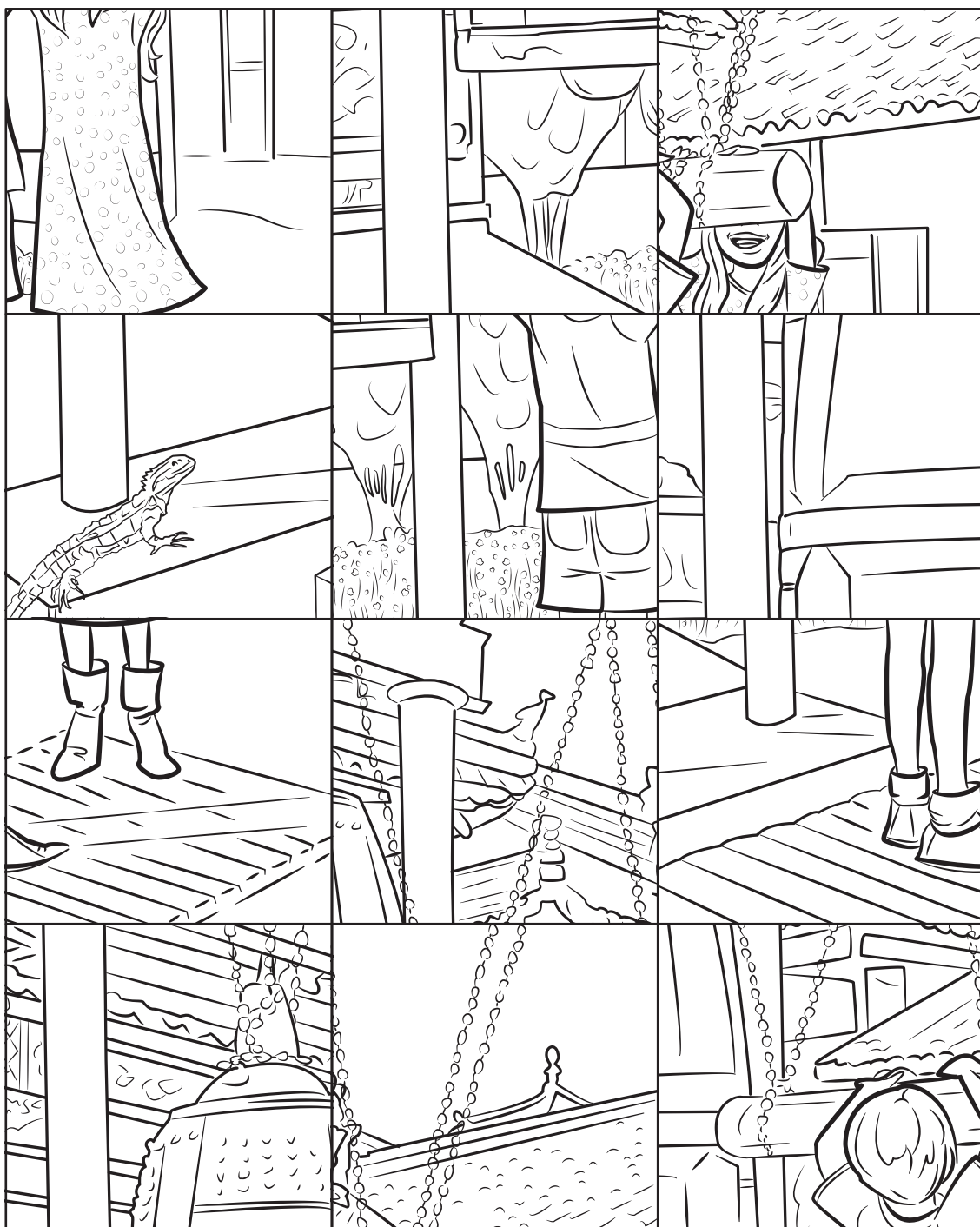
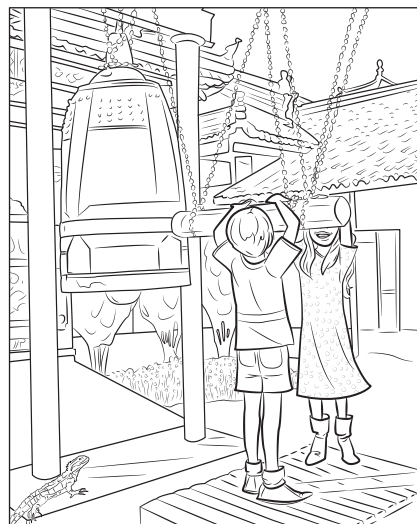
